AN ORDINANCE of the Town of Carthage to delete Section 11-101 of the Municipal Code and replace it with language prohibiting the sale and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages on city owned property or facilities.

WHEREAS, Section 11-101 of the Municipal Code allows for the sale and/or consumption of beer or any other alcoholic beverage in or on any public street, alley, avenue, highway, sidewalk, public park, public school ground or any other public place with a beer permit and license for on premises consumption; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-101 of the Municipal Code allows for the sale and or consumption of beer or any other alcoholic beverage during a "special event" approved by the Town on any city owned property or facilities for charitable, non-profit or political organizations possessing a special occasion license issued by the Alcohol Beverage Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has determined that it is not in the best interest of the Town to allow the sale or consumption of beer or other alcoholic beverages on any city owned property or facilities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Carthage, Tennessee that this ordinance shall delete Section 11-101 of the Municipal Code and replace it with the following new Section 11-101:

"It shall be unlawful for any person to sale, consume, or have an open can or bottle of beer or any alcoholic beverage, in or on any public street, alley, avenue, highway, sidewalk, public park, public school ground, or any other city owned property or facilities."

This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passing.
